**Re: Asbestos Inspections and Management Plans Performed in Compliance with the EPA Regulation:
Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA)**

Jesse Remington High School was inspected for friable and non-friable asbestos containing materials during the spring of 2010 in response to the EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). Following the inspection the school, the information was used to develop a management plan. The plan that was completed in June, 2011 provides for the management of asbestos in a manner to protect human health and the environment.

The inspection was performed and the management plan developed by properly accredited inspectors and management planners employed by RPF Associates, Inc. 320 First NH Turnpike Northwood, NH 03261

The management plan has been submitted to the State of New Hampshire, Department of Education, Division of Standards and Certification, as required by the federal legislation.

The management plan is available for public inspection in the office of Jesse Remington High School. Copies of the management plan may be reproduced at a fee representing the cost of reproduction. Jesse Remington High School has designated Jon Stanley, AHERA Manager for JRHS, 28 Round Hill Road Sandown NH , 603-887-5628, to implement the plan.

A re-inspection, as mandated, will be performed every six months. All reports are available in the office of Jesse Remington High School.
